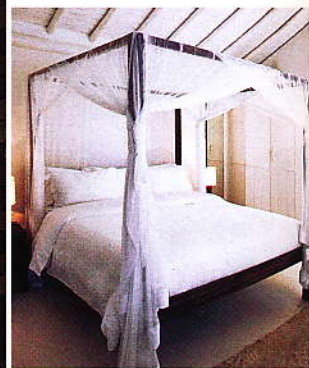

● UXUA CASA / TRANCOSO, BRAZIL

Mingle with South American stunners and sip caipirinhas at this shore thing, a fab collection of nine cottages (and one tree house!) styled by the former creative director of Diesel. Doubles from \$680 (year-round), with breakfast; uxua.com.

● GOLDENEYE / ORACABESSA, JAMAICA

Fulfill the hubster's Bond-girl fantasies at this just-expanded hideaway, the former home of 007's creator, Ian Fleming. Make a dramatic exit from the lagoon in a sassy suit (belt knife optional). Doubles from \$448 (low season) and \$672 (high season), with breakfast; goldeneye.com.

● PLAYA VIVA / ZIHUATANEJO, MEXICO

We're hooked on the eco-friendly casitas, surfer scene, and yum snacks: fresh coconut water and jicama slices, delivered while you sunbathe. Doubles from \$195 (low season) and \$295 (high season), with meals and beer; playaviva.com.

● LA AMADA / PLAYA MUJERES, MEXICO

Close to Cancún but away from its crowds, this sophisticated gem gets an A+ for its two-mile beach and airy rooms, all with to-die-for tubs and terraces. Doubles from \$165 (low season) and \$255 (high season); laamadahotel.com.

● W VIEQUES / VIEQUES, PUERTO RICO

Snogging in a cabana sure works up an appetite: Thank the foodie gods there's an Alain Ducasse restaurant facing the Caribbean. For night action, kayak the nearby "bio bay," which glitters naturally when oars touch the water. Doubles from \$379 (low season) and \$589 (high season); wvieques.com.

● GUANAHANI / ST. BARTS

Pick from two *très jolie* stretches of sand at this remodeled resort. (Twenty suites now feature huge, honeymoon-tastic decks.) Paddleboard or windsurf (the gear is *gratis*), then feast on the catch of the day. Doubles from \$543 (low season) and \$904 (high season), with breakfast; leguanahani.com.

● THE SCENT / KOH SAMUI, THAILAND

A Bangkok-based perfume company created this intoxicating coastal stay, where the Thai-style suites (rattan furniture, sumptuous linens) are as heady as the aromatherapy-influenced spa. Doubles from \$207 (low season) and \$263 (high season), with breakfast; thescenthotel.com.

● WAIKIKI EDITION / HONOLULU

Go ahead and model the room's free-to-borrow pareu—he can bring the ukulele!—at Sunset Beach, an adults-only area with cushy daybeds and bartenders who mix wicked mai tais. Doubles from \$375 (year-round); editionhotels.com.

● DREAM SOUTH BEACH / MIAMI

You'll feel like SoBe royalty at the rooftop lounge, a prime vantage point from which to survey the shimmering Atlantic and the peeps strolling Ocean Drive. Doubles from \$199 (low season) and \$249 (high season); dreamsouthbeach.com.

● SIX SENSES CON DAO / CON DAO, VIETNAM

Should you tire of snorkeling the coral reefs, just retreat to your massive villa and its infinity pool for more dipping—perhaps of the skinny sort. Doubles from \$601 (low season) and \$945 (high season), with breakfast; sixsenses.com.

JAMAICA

Peacocks greet and butlers pamper at **Sandals Royal Plantation** in Ocho Rios, home to the Caribbean's only champagne-and-caviar bar. Doubles from \$1,644 (low season) and \$1,690 (high season), all-inclusive; sandals.com.

LOS CABOS, MEXICO

Staffers at **Las Ventanas al Paraíso** know your needs (screenshot! chips!) before you do. Doubles from \$655 (low season) and \$855 (high season); lasventanas.com.

MAUI, HAWAII

Chow down on mahi sandwiches (the island's tastiest) at the **Ritz-Carlton, Kapalua's** Beach House. Then nap in your room (the island's plushiest). Doubles from \$495 (low season) and \$615 (high season); ritzcarlton.com.

the steal

We have mad love for the boho-style digs, haute-hippie vibe, and bang-for-the-buck rates at **Jake's** in Treasure Beach. Doubles from \$95 (low season) and \$115 (high season); jakeshotel.com.



The **Hilton** and its swim-up infinity-pool bar are a total honeymoon magnet. Doubles from \$199 (low season) and \$249 (high season); hilton.com.

Teak beds and local art adorn main tower rooms at the retro-rad **Royal Lahaina**, set smack-dab in buzzy Kaanapali. Doubles from \$199 (low season) and \$225 (high season); hawaiihotels.com.

just spa it

If your idea of couples therapy includes rubdowns beside the sea, head for **Jamaica Inn** in Ocho Rios. Any closer to the water and you'd need flippers; from \$170.

Get buffed by a seaweed body scrub at **Capella Pedregal**; then stretch out, feeling spiffy, at the spa's oceanfront pool; \$90.

Book a massage in one of the outdoor *hales* at **Four Seasons Wailea** and you'll hear the Pacific on a continuous loop; from \$170.

date night



Ask the locals: Knockin' back a few Red Stripes and devouring jerk lobster alfresco at **Little Ochie** (near Jake's) is their kind of Friday. Dinner for two, \$70.

Chef Gonzo has made a (very cool) name for himself dishing out Mediterranean-meets-Mexican fare at **Esperanza's** bluffside eatery, three stone terraces that cascade down to the sand. Dinner for two, \$130.

Tourists, natives, and Oprah all heart Polynesian-themed **Mama's Fish House**, in Paja, where the homemade desserts (*mmm*—chocolate pie with caramel-cookie crust) are sheer sugar heaven. Dinner for two, \$200.

the life aquatic

Engage in a little horseplay at the **Half Moon Equestrian Centre** in Montego Bay. Your trusty steed will tow you through shallow seas—just hang on for the ride!; \$160 for two.

Whales migrate to Cabo (even they know it's fab) and stay from December through March. Board a boat for a close encounter with some spouting species; \$140 for two.

Set the alarm for an a.m. trip to **Molokini**, an islet off Maui's west coast that's famous for its superb snorkeling; \$160 for two. —J. G., P. M., and E. W.

« TYBEE ISLAND / Georgia

Honeymooners should hole up 30 minutes away at Savannah's ultramod Avia hotel (Drew Barrymore's a fan) and then day-trip to Tybee for water fun. « MARTHA'S VINEYARD / Massachusetts

With its sweeping dunes and New England charm, it's no surprise this tiny isle is a hit with the Obamas. Check into the Outermost Inn, which offers Vineyard Sound views and **Jake Gyllenhaal** sightings: The hunk has been summering close by since childhood. « MONTAUK / New York

Gwyneth Paltrow, Vanessa Minnillo, and *True Blood* cutie **Ryan Kwanten** swing by this laid-back town on Long Island's eastern end. We swooned over the Surf Lodge, the area's hottest nightclub and hotel, which has cheery rooms with private balconies and hammocks...Kwanten not included (sigh). « LONG BRANCH / New Jersey

Snooki and the Situation aside, the Shore isn't all guid-ettes and gorillas. Boldfacers like **Ashley Tisdale** consider it hip thanks to Bungalow, a boutique hotel from *9 by Design's* Cortney and Bob Novogratz. Bunk up there like the Tis and you're close to the Atlantic, shops, and, perhaps, JWoWW. Doubles from \$159 (low season) and \$249 (high season); bungalowhotel.net. —Mark Marino
