5 *The best, hottest jerk pork at one of the roadside shacks along Boston Bay.*

6 *A stay at Goldeneye, the former home of Ian Fleming, who wrote thirteen James Bond novels while living there. It's now a hideaway perfect for a honeymoon.*

7 *Steak grilled with Pickapeppa sauce and served on the terrace at Half Moon's Sugar Mill restaurant.*

8 *Live reggae along Montego Bay's Hip Strip.*

9 *Horseback riding on the beach—and in the ocean (book with Chukka Caribbean Adventures).*

10 *Fettuccine Alfredo with fish, lobster, and shrimp at Evita's Italian restaurant overlooking Ocho Rios.*

11 *Cycling with Blue Mountain Bicycle Tours for scenic views of the island's coasts.*

12 *Dining under the stars accompanied by an old-fashioned dance band, at the romantic Jamaica Inn, seemingly unchanged since the 1950s (six-course menu, \$70; reserve in advance).*

13 *A visit to nearly deserted Treasure Beach on the still-quiet south coast.*

14 *Rich, robust Jamaica Blue Mountain Coffee.*

15 *The wild, dance-'til-dawn nightlife at The Jungle in Mariner's Negril Beach Club, a favorite of music-industry types.*

16 *Handmade wooden boxes, lithographs, and prints at Harmony Hall.*

17 *Visiting sleepy Port Antonio, once home to actor Errol Flynn, and snorkeling at Blue Lagoon.*

18 *The Caves, ten thatched-roof cottages on Negril's cliffs—chic independence amid a sea of all-inclusives.*

19 *Ice cream that's traditionally made with coconut milk.*

20 *Floating on a bamboo raft along the Rio Grande, listening to your rafter spin stories about his hometown.*

21 *A tour of Firefly, the former home of playwright Noël Coward (the views alone are worth the trip).*

22 *Ice-cold Red Stripe beer.*

23 *Learning how rum is made and enjoying the generous samples offered at the Appleton Estate distillery.*

24 *A scented bubble bath drawn by your very own British-trained butler at Sandals Negril Beach Resort and Spa.*
