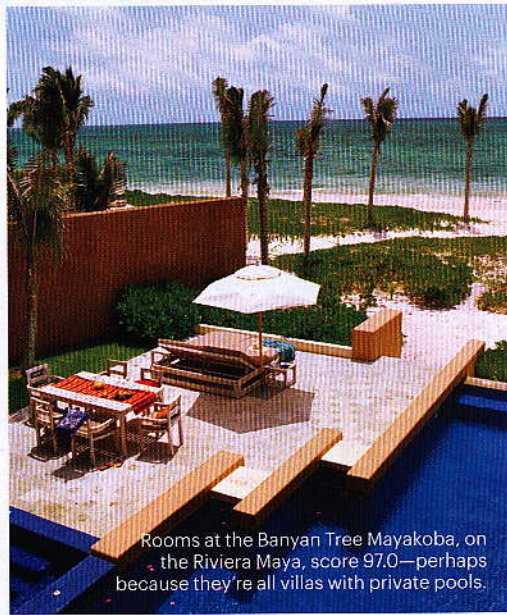

The Americas

In an area stretching from Canada to Chile, it's our southern neighbor—Mexico—that shines the brightest

WHILE THE diversity of this region is dazzling, our readers give their emphatic endorsement to the hotels and resorts in Mexico. The country has a staggering 33 properties on the list this year—the most ever for Mexico and more than one-third the total in the Americas. Of these properties, 11 are new to the list, all of them coastal resorts. Among Caribbean islands, the current pacesetter is St. Lucia, with five luxe hotels that showcase the island's stunning topography. Elsewhere in the Americas, a hotel near the main plaza in Cuzco, Peru, and two Lilliputian properties—one a 14-room wine lodge in the viticulture center of Argentina, the other a 16-room eco-resort amid 500 acres of dense forest in central Costa Rica—join the list, while a couple of sleek urban hotels also debut in Canada.



Rooms at the Banyan Tree Mayakoba, on the Riviera Maya, score 97.0—perhaps because they're all villas with private pools.

This six-year-old resort is “a dream come true.” Gazebos made of Indonesian woods are clustered around the central reflecting pool. Airy pavilions feature terraces with daybeds and sunken dining areas—“they bring a touch of modernity to the islands.” Asian and Mediterranean dishes fill the menu at the main restaurant.
